

Rules and Regulations Teleférico de Fuente Dé

For reasons of safety and/or public-spiritedness, users must follow the instructions and directions of the staff at the facilities.

In order to facilitate smooth operation and ensure the safety of the facilities, users must respect the order of arrival.

Tickets should be purchased at the points designated for this purpose.

Users must keep and carry their ticket with them at all times and show it when required by the staff of the facility.

Users must respect the rules of the facility and behave properly towards staff and other users.

Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

Return tickets may only be used on the date specified on the ticket.

When the facility has to close due to reasons of force majeure, safety reasons or adverse weather conditions, the amount of the ticket will not be refunded, except to users who are on the lower level and have not used their ticket.

The transportation of animals is not permitted (except guide dogs and save-and-rescue dogs).

The user must deposit any type of waste at the points provided for this purpose. Leaving or dumping waste at the facility or in the environment of the National Park may involve opening disciplinary proceedings in accordance with Law 6/1995 of May 30, on the Declaration of the Picos de Europa National Park.

The facility will not be liable for accidents caused by unforeseen circumstances or the negligence of the user at the facility or in its surroundings.

Tickets include VAT and Compulsory Travellers Insurance. The facility has complaint forms available to users. They may be requested at the ticket offices or at the lower station.

The facility is for tourist, leisure and sports use.

Recommendations

- Please take off your backpacks before entering the cable car.
- The person in charge / agency guide will be responsible for acquiring all the tickets for the group.
- Mountain bikes will be taken up free on the first two trips or when there are no passengers to take up.

- In the afternoon, queues may form, so it is advisable to bring warm clothes because there may be sudden changes in weather.
- Smoking is prohibited in the upper and lower stations and in the cable cars, in accordance with Law 42/2010, of December 30, 2010.
